<b>Job Description</b>			
<p><b>ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES</b></p> <p>As the Corps Division of the IFOC continues to grow, additional command staff are required to help monitor and support the Corps. The Deputy Regional Commander position will support regions of the United States where there are multiple corps and virtual groups under the guidance of the Regional Commander.</p> <p>To support Corps Commanders and Regional Virtual Captains as assigned over a portion of the United States.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be the first point of contact to help resolve any problems or challenges the Corps Commanders have.</li> <li>• Build relationships with all Corps Commanders, Assistant Commanders, and Virtual Leaders assigned.</li> <li>• To keep abreast of the happenings of the IFOC Chaplains / groups in their assigned region.</li> </ul> <p>Promote IFOC to assigned Corps and Virtual Groups by building relationships.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Help facilitate the monthly regional leaders conference/virtual meeting.</li> <li>2. Regional Commanders should build relationships by supporting assigned staff, helping resolve problems, visiting Corps meetings occasionally either personally or remotely (conference call, virtual meeting, etc), and getting to know assigned command staff under their authority.</li> </ol> <p>To help assign new Chaplains to either a Corps or Virtual Group.</p> <p>The Regional Commander is put in place to help support the Corps assigned to them, not to direct their operations. Each Corps Commander is responsible to direct their own corps activities as long as it is within the scope and spirit of the IFOC. The Regional Commander and their Deputy does help provide accountability for all assigned staff and helps resolve problems that come up in daily operations. Regional Commander should report significant problems up the chain of command to the Executive Director of Corps and the Deputy Director of Corps Operations.</p>			
<b>Qualifications and Educational Requirements</b>			
<p>Must be an Ordained Chaplain with the IFOC          Must have their pastor / spiritual overseer's recommendation for Christian Leadership          Have an understanding of Chain of Command and coordination of multiple DBA business units.</p> <p><b>PREFERRED SKILLS</b></p> <p>Must be able to practice servant leadership. While this position is in authority over assigned Corps Commanders, this position is a helps position designed to assist the Corps Commanders and provide a bridge between the Corps and Virtual Groups and the IFOC Executive Director of Corps.</p> <p><b>Must have computer / phone conference skills to conduct meetings remotely.</b></p>
